- **Library Instruction.** Library faculty teach research skills to classes, small groups, and individuals on campus, off-campus, and online. In addition, the Library offers undergraduate courses and continuing education workshops on Digital Information Literacy. Contact your campus library to schedule a library instruction session with a librarian or for more information about library credit courses and continuing education workshops.
- **Reference and Research Assistance.** Librarians are available by appointment, by phone, through email, and through instant messaging to students and faculty for individual or group research help. Call a campus library below to set up an appointment that meets your schedule with a librarian.
- **LibGuides.** These interactive subject guides provide research strategies, links to suggested resources, and in-depth information on various library resources and tools for NLU courses, programs, and departments. These guides will help you find specialized resources and provide tutorials and instruction in utilizing the library.
- **Tutorials & Handouts.** A variety of tutorials and handouts are available on the Library's Web site to guide users through the process of conducting research at the University Library. In addition to the interactive, voice-narrated versions, many of these tutorials are also available in text or handout formats that easily can be viewed and printed.
- **Journal Article Databases.** The NLU Library subscribes to many databases that provide online access to journals, newspapers, and other types of information, much of it available in full text. Access to journal article databases is available off-campus through My NLU Portal.
- **Online Book Catalogs.** The NLU online book catalog for all NLU Libraries (and electronic reserves) and the I-Share catalog, which includes the holdings of more than 70 other academic libraries in Illinois, can be accessed through the Library's Web site. In addition, NLU patrons can request, renew, and check their accounts online. The Library also provides access to full text electronic books through eBrary and NetLibrary.
- **Citing Sources.** The Library's Web site provides access to several helpful Web sites on how to cite your sources in various citation styles including APA. For example, [Style Wizard](#) is a popular resource that will help you build an APA citation that you can copy and paste into your bibliography.
- **RefWorks.** Available to all NLU students, faculty, and staff, RefWorks is an online citation management tool. With RefWorks you can export citations directly from journal article databases, organize and manage references in folders, and format in-text citations and bibliographies in seconds.
- **ILLiad.** Journal articles not available in full text through NLU may be requested and accessed through this document delivery service. Books not available through the NLU or I-Share can also be requested through ILLiad and may be picked up at any NLU library location or mailed to distance learning or off-campus students. Assistance with creating an ILLiad account and requesting articles is available at each campus library or by calling one of the numbers below.
- **Off-Campus Access.** All of the Library's resources are available to you from off-campus, from anywhere you have an Internet connection. To access the Library's resources, login to your My NLU Portal (where you access your student email) and click on the [NLU Library](#) link.
